Bids received after the time fixed for the opening will not be considered.

A pre-bid meeting will be held in the Terminal Building upstairs conference room at 1:00 pm, local time <u>April 5, 2018</u>, for those interested contractors, subcontractors, and suppliers.

The project consists of, realigning existing Taxiway A from Taxiway C to Taxiway E; rehabilitation of Taxiway A from Runway 3L/21R to Taxiway C; construction of Taxiway D high-speed connector; construction of Taxilane A Spur, and Runway Intersection Underdrains.

Work will consist of, but is not limited to, realignment and construction of approximately 4,200 LF of the eastern portion of Taxiway A and rehabilitation of 4,200 LF of Taxiways A, B and C at the Tri-Cities Airport, Pasco, WA. Work includes removal of asphalt concrete pavement and cement treated base, pavement milling and profiling, excavation, subgrade preparation, grading, and placement of underdrain piping, drywells, catch basins, crushed aggregate base course, cement treated base, bituminous surfacing, electrical and lighting modifications, lighted guidance signing, and striping.
