CALL TO ORDER

Commissioner Reimann called the meeting to order at 10:30 a.m.

<u>Airport Liability Insurance</u> – Mr. McEuin, Conover Insurance, discussed the Airport Liability Insurance. Commissioner Klindworth moved and Commissioner Ryckman seconded to approve the airport liability insurance as presented. Motion passed unanimously.

Terminal Building Expansion Project - Mr. Robison informed Commission and staff that the project will be completed for the ribbon cutting event on January 27th. He presented for commissioner review and approval Change Order #19 and RCAR #17. Commissioner Klindworth moved and Commissioner Ryckman seconded to approve change order #19 for \$57,800.18 and RCAR #17 for \$10,337.63. Motion carried unanimously.

Mr. Hayden informed Commission that the Tri-Cities Airport Dedication event will be held on January 27, 2017 at 11:00 a.m. with public tours to follow that evening.

<u>Delta Airlines and Alaska Airlines Operating Agreement</u> - Commissioner Ryckman moved and Commissioner Klindworth seconded to approve the Delta Airlines and Alaska Airlines Operating Agreements, which extends the term of their current agreements through December 31, 2019. Motion carried unanimously.

<u>Economic Development Services Interlocal Agreement</u> – Mr. Hayden stated that the City of Pasco would like to renew the Economic Development Services Interlocal Agreement for one year. Commissioner Klindworth moved and Commissioner Ryckman seconded to authorize the Executive Director to execute the Economic Development Services Interlocal Agreement with City of Pasco, and take such other actions as may be necessary to fulfill the terms of the agreement. Motion carried unanimously.

ITEMS FOR DISCUSSION

November 2016 Financial Statement – Mrs. O'Brien discussed the November 2016 Financial Statement.

Tenant Delinquent List - Mrs. O'Brien discussed the current tenant delinquent list.

Airport Director's Report:

- 1. Mr. Foraker reported on the winter operations during this most recent snowstorm. The maintenance crew put in over 129 hours of overtime to keep the airport operational. He also stated that the FAA requires all NOTAMs be issued electronically to expedite the notification process for airlines. This process seems to be working well.
- 2. Mr. Foraker reported that sometime this spring the Airport will solicit Request for Qualifications for Airline Service Development at the Tri-Cities Airport.
- 3. Mr. Foraker reported that Columbia Basin Paper was the low-bid to provide all disposable paper products at the Tri-Cities Airport.
- 4. Year to date enplanements for 2016 were up 9% over 2015. Total enplanements for 2016 were 374,254, a 26,195-passenger increase over 2015 totals.

Ag Hall of Fame – Mr. Hayden informed Commissioners that Commissioner Ryckman will present the Visionary Award to former Port Director Jim Toomey, Former City of Pasco Administrator Gary Crutchfield, and former Franklin PUD Director Ken Sugden at the January 19, 2017 Ag Hall of Fame event.

ITEMS FOR INFORMATION/ NO DISCUSSION

Executed Items:

- 1. LaFarge North America, Inc. Lease This is a rail license agreement, not to exceed 5 months, for 1,500 linear feet rail on track #450 in the Big Pasco Industrial Center for storage of surplus rail cars at the monthly published lease rate of \$3,750.00.
- 2. Rick Dorman This is a month-to-month lease agreement for Building 1-69, #3 at the Tri-Cities Airport at the monthly published lease rate of \$192.69.

Mr. Ballew joined the commission meeting at 12:15 pm, and was present for the remainder of the meeting.

RECESS

At 12:15 p.m., Commissioner Reimann recessed the meeting for fifteen minutes for lunch. At 12:30 p.m., the meeting was reconvened.

EXECUTIVE SESSION

At 12:30 p.m., Commissioner Reimann announced that the board would go into executive session for twenty minutes to consider the minimum price at which real estate will be offered for sale or lease; and to discuss with legal counsel representing the agency matters relating to Potential Legal Action. At 12:50 p.m. the regular meeting was reconvened.

ITEMS NOT ON AGENDA

1. Mr. Hayden stated that with the Airport Expansion Project nearing completion, Darren McEuin and Linda O'Brien have completed a review of the value of the Tri-Cities Airport Terminal Facility for replacement value insurance coverage. The new valuation for the airport terminal is between \$60 million to \$75 million. After discussing the drivers used to achieve this new valuation, Commissioners agreed that the appropriate valuation amount would be \$70 million. Mrs. O'Brien and Mr. McEuin will communicate this information to Enduris. Mr. McEuin was asked to provide premium costs for higher deductibles, which will be shared at a future Commission meeting.
