

RESOLUTION NO. 1530

A RESOLUTION OF THE PORT OF PASCO AUTHORIZING SUBMITTAL OF APPLICATION TO THE COMMUNITY ECONOMIC REVITALIZATION BOARD (CERB) FOR THE REIMANN INDUSTRIAL CENTER MASTER PLAN

WHEREAS, the Community Economic Revitalization Board (CERB) of the State of Washington Department of Community Trade and Economic Development is authorized to make grants and loans for infrastructure planning for qualified applicants of Washington State Municipalities, including the Port of Pasco, located in a designated rural county; and

WHEREAS, CERB is authorized to make grants through the Planning and Economic Feasibility Program; and

WHEREAS, the Port of Pasco is seeking to develop a new industrial park to recruit new industries and support the growth of existing industries in Franklin County through the development of the Reimann Industrial Center; and


WHEREAS, appropriate development of the Reimann Industrial Center will require careful planning and analysis, which the Port of Pasco proposes to perform through a Master Planning process.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED BY THE PORT OF PASCO AS FOLLOWS:

1. Randy Hayden, Executive Director of the Port of Pasco, is authorized to submit an application to CERB for a \$50,000 grant to conduct Master Planning for the 300 acre Reimann Industrial Center.
2. A copy of this resolution shall be submitted with the CERB application.
3. The application shall be effective immediately upon passage and signature by the Port of Pasco Commissioners.
