

RESOLUTION NO. 1673

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE CUSTOMER FACILITY CHARGE COLLECTION RATE AT THE TRI-CITIES AIRPORT

WHEREAS, The Port of Pasco, Washington has undertaken a capital improvement program to facilitate major customer service improvements at the Tri-Cities Airport (Airport); and

WHEREAS, The Port of Pasco operates, maintains and develops the Airport, in part with federal grants, Passenger Facility Charges, Customer Facility Charges (CFC) and user fees; and

WHEREAS, Customer Facility Charges (CFC) have become common financing tools for landside improvements at airports: and

WHEREAS, Port Management believes it would be beneficial to continue to provide the terminal and landside improvements to the traveling public including new rental car offices and service facilities, ready return lots and storage facilities using CFCs for the purposes of financing, designing, constructing, operating and maintaining these and other landside improvements;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE PORT OF PASCO PORT COMMISSION, THAT:

SECTION 1: The Airport Director shall establish and periodically adjust as required, a daily CFC upon each airport rental car companies' customer's rental contract.

SECTION 2: The CFC will be collected on a daily basis for all cars rented for twenty-four or fewer hours for the first transaction day, and every twenty-four hours for each transaction day thereafter.

SECTION 3: The CFC shall be established at \$5.00 per transaction day.

SECTION 4: The CFC will be collected by all rental car companies operating at the Airport.

SECTION 5: The CFC collected by the rental car companies shall be held in trust by the rental car companies for the benefit of the Airport and shall be remitted monthly to the Port of Pasco in accordance with procedures established by the Finance Director/Auditor.


SECTION 6: Rental car companies and their agents hold only a possessory interest in the CFC, and no legal or equitable interest.

SECTION 7: That this resolution shall take effect immediately upon execution.

This Resolution supersedes Resolutions 1333, 1609 and any other previous Resolutions referencing a Customer Facility Charge (CFC).
